

## "We Shall Meet Him in The Air."

The Lord inspired me to engage the Chapel in revival for October. It would be a time for renewal, reconciliation, and refreshing from the Holy Spirit. Our Theme is ***"We Shall Meet Him in the Air."*** The purpose of revival is to have a spiritual reawakening focus on what God has promised for our eternal security and share the message of Salvation for the lost. Here are the seven action points:

- 1. It involves giving God preeminence by seeking Him with renewed zeal and commitment. Matthew 6:33:** *"But seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you."*
- 2. It is mandatory to create the atmosphere to invite the presence of the Lord when we gather. Psalms 100:4-5** *"Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with Praise: Be thankful unto Him and bless His Holy name. For the Lord is good, His mercy is everlasting, And His truth endures to all generations."*
- 3. It requires repentance of spiritual indifference in grieving the prompting of the Holy Spirit to follow Him in Faith. Ephesians 4:30-32 ESV:** *"And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. 31 Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and slander be put away from you, along with malice. 32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God has forgiven you."*
- 4. It is essential to ask the Lord to renew the right spirit within for transparency and repentance to promote healing. James 5:16:** *"Confess your faults one to another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much."*
- 5. Earnestly praying for others to seek the wisdom of God and accept a relationship with Jesus in their lives. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18** *Rejoice always, 17 pray without ceasing, 18 give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."*
- 6. We are to redeem the time in the power of the Holy Spirit because the days are evil, and we don't have the luxury of procrastinating for the perfect time to share our faith. Ephesians 5:16-18** *16 Make the best use of your time. These are sinful days, 17 Do not be foolish. Understand what the Lord wants you to do. 18 Do not get drunk with wine. That leads to wild living. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit.*
- 7. We must pray & fast that the Lord will bring down the walls that have kept people from attaining an eternal relationship with God. Ephesians 6:12:** *"For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places."*
