1. We have been given LIFE, man and woman.

Scripture Text: Genesis 15:5-6 NKJV 5 Then He brought him outside and said, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be." 6 And he believed in the Lord, and He accounted it to him for righteousness.

Romans 12:3 NKJV For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.

Scripture Text: Genesis 6:7-8 NKJV 7 And the Lord said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and of the birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them. 8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord.

Ephesians 2:8-10 NIV For it is grace you have been saved, and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God **9** not by works so that no one can boast. **10** For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Grace is not earned through personal accomplishments. Grace from God is always unmerited. People look for ways to earn (favor/grace) from others through loyalty, whether they please God or not.

As believers and members of the body of Christ, we are given assignments to do unto the Lord and not for man. We may not carry them out like experts or professionals, but we prayerfully ask God's help to bless others. We faithfully complete our assignments for His glory and not for selfish reasons.

2. Thanks for giving us... GRACE!

Scripture Text: Psalms 130:7 NKJV *O Israel, hope in the Lord; for your Lord there is mercy, and with him is abundant redemption.*

Without God's mercy, we were lost with the sentence of death and eternal separation from Him because of sin. **Romans 6:23** FOR THE WAGES OF SIN IS DEATH, BUT THE GIFT OF GOD is <u>Eternal Life in Christ Jesus our Lord</u>.

Ephesians 1:7 NIV In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace.

Scripture Text: Psalms 119:89 AMP *Forever, O Lord, Your word is settled in heaven [standing firm and unchangeable].*
