John 12: 1-8 (NKJV)

- 1. Then, six days before the Passover, Jesus came to Bethany, where Lazarus, who had been dead, was, whom He had raised from the dead.
- 2 There they made Him a supper, and Martha served, but Lazarus was one of those who sat at the table with Him.
